Window Painting Guidelines & Information:

- Kids in grades Kindergarten through 6th are only allowed to participate.
- A donation of at least one canned food item for the F.I.S.H. Pantry is requested.
(You are encouraged to bring lots of canned food items to help the hungry.)
- Pick up your paint and drop off canned goods on Saturday morning at 1025 Curtiss.
- You must bring your own brushes, towels, water and other materials other than the paint.
(Paint will be supplied to participants courtesy of the Rotary Club Of Downers Grove, the Downtown Downers Grove Management Corporation and Carlson Paint, Glass & Art Stores. Paint available while supplies last.)
- Water based paints are the only type of paints permitted! Paint may be applied to the glass portion of the window only. Dark paints can't be used over large areas of the windows.
- Painting can begin as early as 9 a.m. and conclude by 1 p.m.
- No reserving of windows permitted.
